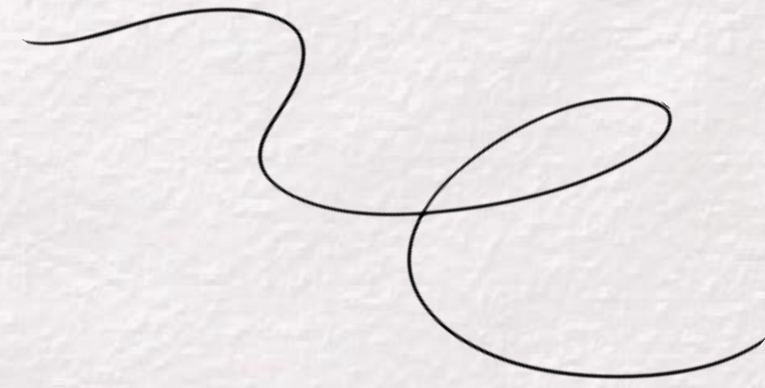

 - In Autumn term we will be recapping the 2's-12's timetables, then applying this to our learning in Math's lessons. Please complete the weekly timetables book, and log in to TTR to support this.



Behaviour:

- Children may lose part of their breaks for poor choices / incomplete work / wearing non uniform eg trainers / jewellery



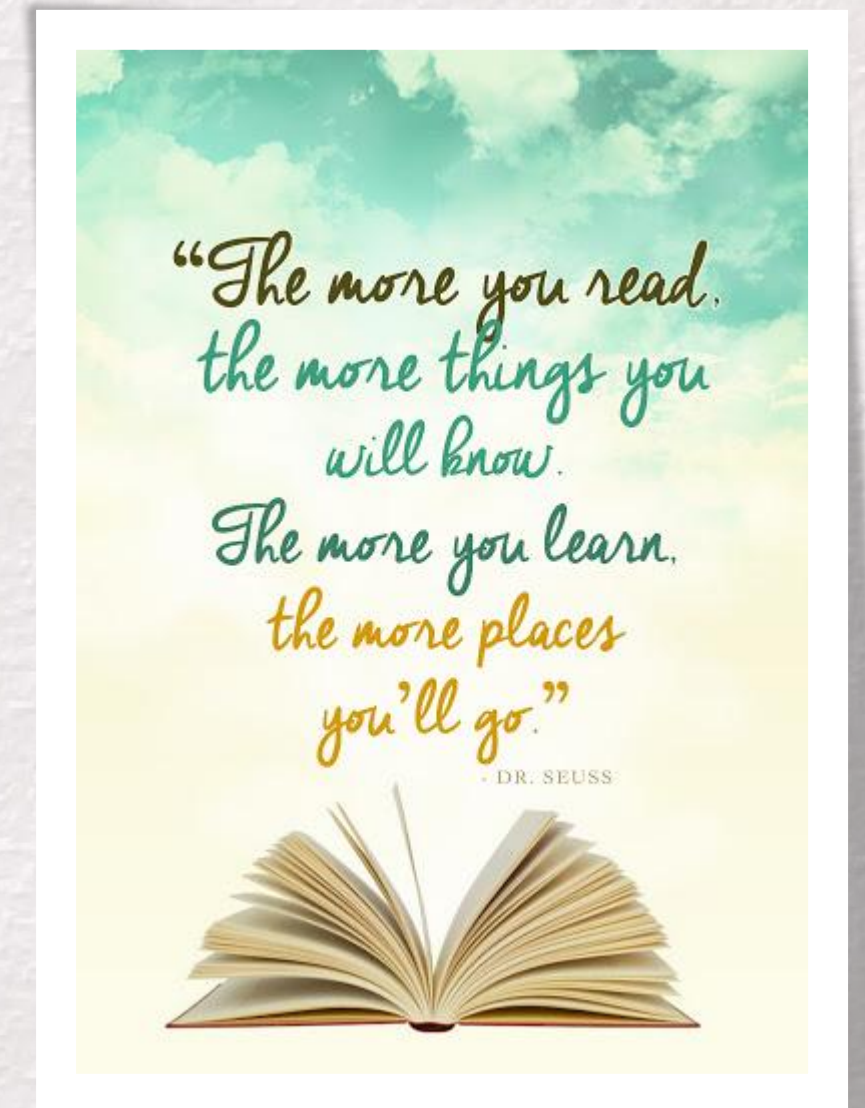
Reading

All children should be reading at home everyday.
They have a reading record which evidences their reading.

This needs to be recorded at home and signed by you at least 4 times per week.

Daily reading increases their vocab and understanding of spelling grammar and punctuation.

Regular reading = progress.
