Regular reading = progress.

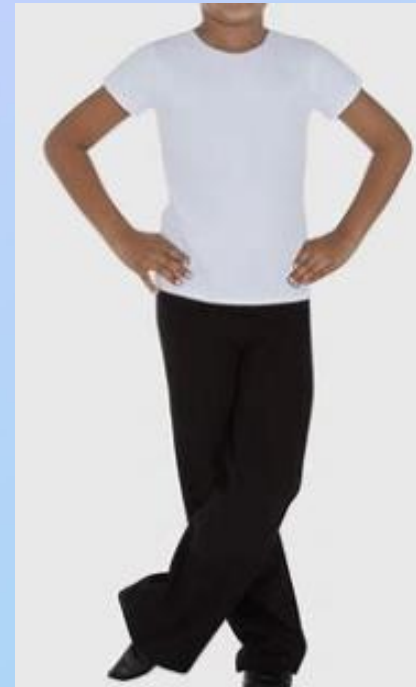


# PE Days and uniform

Uniform is as follows:

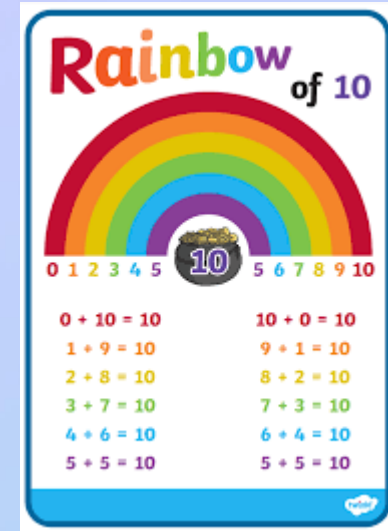
- Plain white T shirt
