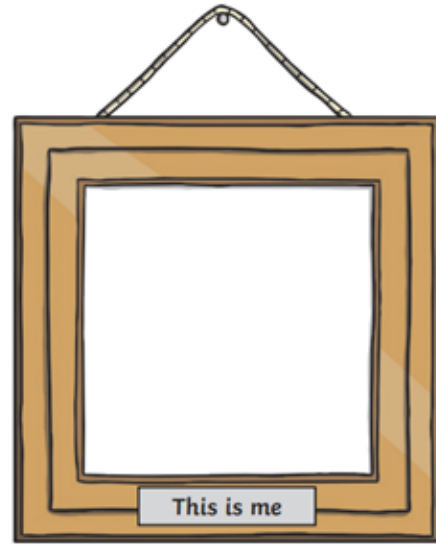

Regular reading = progress.

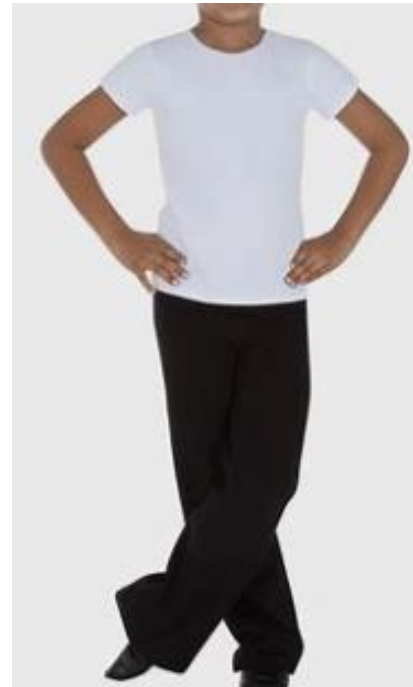


PE Days and uniform

Your PE day is Tuesday. Please arrive in school in your PE kit as you will be spending FULL day in it.

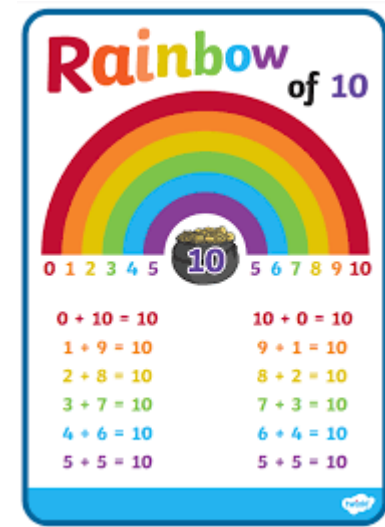
Uniform is as follows:
